

There are two types of letters in English alphabets:


































SHORT VOWEL SOUND

Short vowel Rule: When one-syllable words have a vowel in the middle, the Vowel usually has a short sound.



The short 'A' sound is what you hear in words like "bat" or "cat". Here are some examples of words with the short 'A' sound.
