UNIT 1: LET'S HAVE FUN

Lesson 1: Papa's Spectacles

- Question:** What was Papa searching for all over the house in the poem 'Papa's Spectacles'?
Answer: Papa was searching for his lost pair of **spectacles**.
- Question:** Which daily activities could Papa not perform without his spectacles?
Answer: Without his spectacles, Papa could not **read the newspaper, watch TV, or cut vegetables**.
- Question:** Name three places inside the house where Papa looked for his spectacles.
Answer: Papa checked inside his **pockets**, looked under his **chair**, and searched near the **window**.
- Question:** How many pairs of spectacles did Papa possess according to the poem?
Answer: Papa possessed only **one single pair** of spectacles.
- Question:** Where were Papa's spectacles finally located at the end of the poem?
Answer: The lost spectacles were found placed in an obvious spot right on Papa's own **head/forehead**.

Lesson 2: Gone with the Scooter

- Question:** What was Gopi doing on a summer afternoon before he heard a noise in the garden?
Answer: Gopi was sitting in the veranda **reading a book**.
- Question:** What sound did Gopi hear in the garden, and what did he think caused it?
Answer: Gopi heard a **rustling sound** followed by a **thud**, and he initially thought a **mango** had fallen from the tree.
- Question:** What object did Gopi actually discover hidden between the thick grass in the garden?
Answer: Gopi found a **white hockey ball** in the thick grass.
- Question:** Why did Gopi's mother ask him to come back inside the house?
Answer: She called him inside because it was **very hot** out in the garden.
- Question:** How did the hockey ball end up inside the passing scooterist's basket?
Answer: Jay hit the ball so hard with his stick that it flew past the playground gate and landed right into the **basket of a passing scooter**.
- Question:** How did the children react when the scooterist drove away unaware with their ball?
Answer: The children looked at each other and **burst into laughter**.

UNIT 2: MY COLOURFUL WORLD

Lesson 3: The Rainbow

- Question:** Who composed the poem 'The Rainbow'?
Answer: The poem was written by **Christina Rossetti**.
- Question:** Where do boats and ships sail according to the poem?
Answer: **Boats** sail on the rivers, and **ships** sail on the seas.
- Question:** What sails across the sky and is described as being prettier than boats and ships?
Answer: **Clouds** that sail across the sky are described as prettier than boats and ships.
- Question:** What builds a road from the earth to the sky in the poem 'The Rainbow'?
Answer: The **rainbow ("bow")** builds a road from earth to sky.
- Question:** What natural features does the rainbow overtop in the poem?

Answer: The rainbow bridges heaven and **overtops the trees**.

Lesson 4: The Wise Parrot

1. **Question:** Where did the rich merchant keep his bright and talkative parrot?

Answer: The rich merchant kept his parrot in a **cage of gold**.

2. **Question:** What message did the caged parrot ask the merchant to deliver to its wild friends in the far-off land?

Answer: The parrot asked the merchant to inform its friends that it was living in captivity inside a cage.

3. **Question:** What lesson did the wild forest parrot teach the caged parrot through its actions?

Answer: The wild parrot showed that by **pretending to be dead**, the owner would open the cage and set the bird free.

4.Question: How did the wise parrot finally manage to escape and fly away into the open sky?

Answer: The parrot feigned death until the merchant opened the cage and stepped back, whereupon it stretched its green wings and **flew off into the open sky**.
